Job Description

Job Title: Lifeguard

Position Purpose:

To further the mission of Lake Francis Resort and Camp Rockin' U by providing supervision and ensuring a safe environment at the camp's waterfront and pool activities. Assist in the management to the physical operation of the waterfront and pool facilities and equipment.

Essential Job Functions:

1. Supervise and guard all waterfront and pool activities
 - a. Provide surveillance during aquatic activities to help prevent and to manage injuries
 - b. Provide rescues as needed
 - c. Utilize first aid and CPR and other emergency management services as needed.
 - d. Understand and implement appropriate response to changes in water conditions or weather conditions affecting the waterfront
 - e. Evaluate aquatics abilities of guests, campers, and staff
2. Assist waterfront staff in program areas such as swimming and boating
 - a. Ensure campers and staff follow safety procedures while in their program activity
 - b. Act as reference in waterfront and pool activities
 - c. Assist in the delivery and supervision of all water activities and special events at the waterfront and pool
3. Assist in the management and care of the physical facilities and equipment in all waterfront and pool areas.
 - a. Conduct daily checks of area and equipment for safety, cleanliness and good repair.

- b. Clean waterfront and pool area daily keeping them free of hazards and debris.
- 4. Willing to be cross trained and help run program areas (Climbing wall, archery, pellet guns, arts and crafts, Segways)

Other Job Duties:

- During Camp Rockin' U summer camp sessions, willing to be in the cabin is a great plus.
- Attend applicable staff meetings and trainings.
- Participate enthusiastically in all camp activities, planning and leading those as assigned
- Participate as a member of the camp staff team to deliver and supervise evening programs, special events, overnights, and other all-camp activities and camp functions as assigned
- Assist in the planning of any special events on or near the waterfront or pool
- Maintain clear and positive written and verbal communication with all resort staff.
- All other duties and tasks as assigned

Equipment Used:

- Waterfront:
 - Kayaks, paddle boards, peddle boats, canoes, row boats, life-vests
- First aid and cpr equipment and supplies

Qualifications:

- Current certification in lifeguard training
- Current certification in first aid and CPR.
- Must pass a background check

Knowledge, Skills, and Abilities:

- Current instructional certification in programs offered or related experience.
- Training and experience in waterfront activities that are offered
- Desire and ability to work with people outdoors.

Physical Aspects of the Position:

- Ability to communicate and work with groups participating (age and skill levels) and provide necessary instruction to campers and staff.
- Ability to observe camper behavior, assess its appropriateness, enforce appropriate safety regulations and emergency procedures and apply appropriate behavior-management techniques.
- Ability to observe staff behavior, assess its appropriateness, enforce appropriate safety regulations and emergency procedures, and apply appropriate management techniques.
- Visual and auditory ability to identify and respond to environmental and other hazards related to the activity.
- Physical ability to respond appropriately to situations requiring first aid. Must be able to assist campers in an emergency (fire, evacuation, illness, or injury) and possess strength and endurance required to maintain constant supervision of campers.
- Willingness to live and or work in an outdoor environment, being subject to weather elements.
